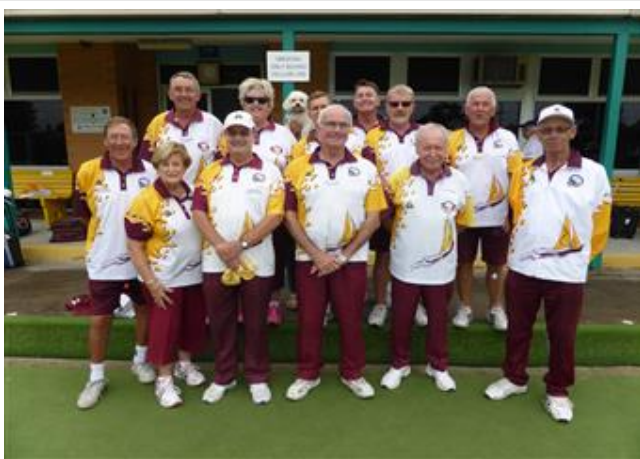

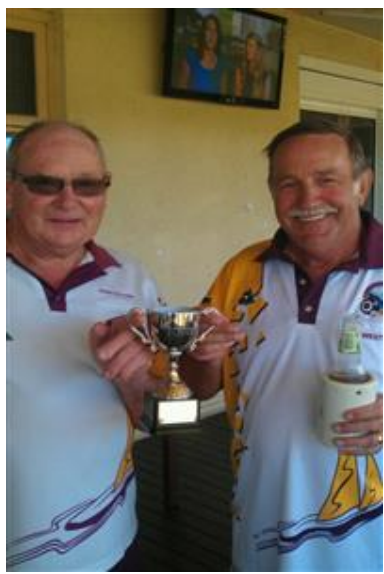


## Ladies Pairs Final 2016

# Smart Phones

## Gizmo Blog

In the second of our articles about Smartphones, we will focus on Apple iPhone and some of the steps involved in setting up a new phone. As discussed in our first article, the Apple iPhone is the easier phone to use but there are some basic concepts that you need to understand.

### AppleID

Your AppleID is the key to the door with anything Apple.

Your Apple ID is the account you use to access Apple services like the App Store, Apple Music, iCloud, iMessage, FaceTime and more. And you can sign in to all Apple services with a single Apple ID and password.

### Create your Apple ID

To get started, go to the Apple ID site and select Create Your Apple ID (<https://appleid.apple.com/>) Here's what you need:

- A valid email address to use as your Apple ID username.

- A strong password.

- Your date of birth.

- Three security questions and answers to verify your identity

- A rescue email address.

You can also use this information to reset your password.

You can also create your Apple ID when you set up a new device, or sign in to iTunes or iCloud for the first time.

### Sign in with your Apple ID

Use the same Apple ID and password every time you're asked to sign in to an Apple device or service. With your Apple ID, you can seamlessly:

- Sign in to iCloud to keep your personal content up to date on all your devices.

- Sign in to the iTunes, iBooks, and App Store to make purchases and access previous purchases.

- Sign in to iMessage and FaceTime with your Apple ID to talk and text with friends and family.

- Sign in to Game Center with your Apple ID to play games with friends and track your achievements.

- Sign in with your Apple ID when you set up a new device.

### What Next?

I have setup my AppleID, so what next? You can now buy your favourite song or album to carry around with you to listen where ever you like. Just go to the iTunes Store app, look for your favourite song/album, enter your AppleID and password when requested, purchase the song/album and it will be down loaded to your iPhone. Plugin your earphones, startup the Music app, select your favourite song/album, set the volume you want and

then hit Play. Music should now be filling your ears so sit back and enjoy.

The next thing you can do with your AppleID is buy a new app that you can use to measure bowls in a head and which is shot bowl. The app is called Shot Bowl and cost \$2 to buy. Just go to the App Store, select search and search for the Shot Bowl app, when found, select "Install", enter your AppleID and password when requested and the app will be downloaded to your iPhone. You can open the app and measure away!

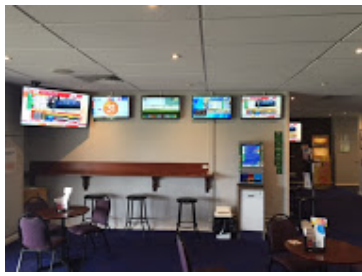
## TAB Comes to Town

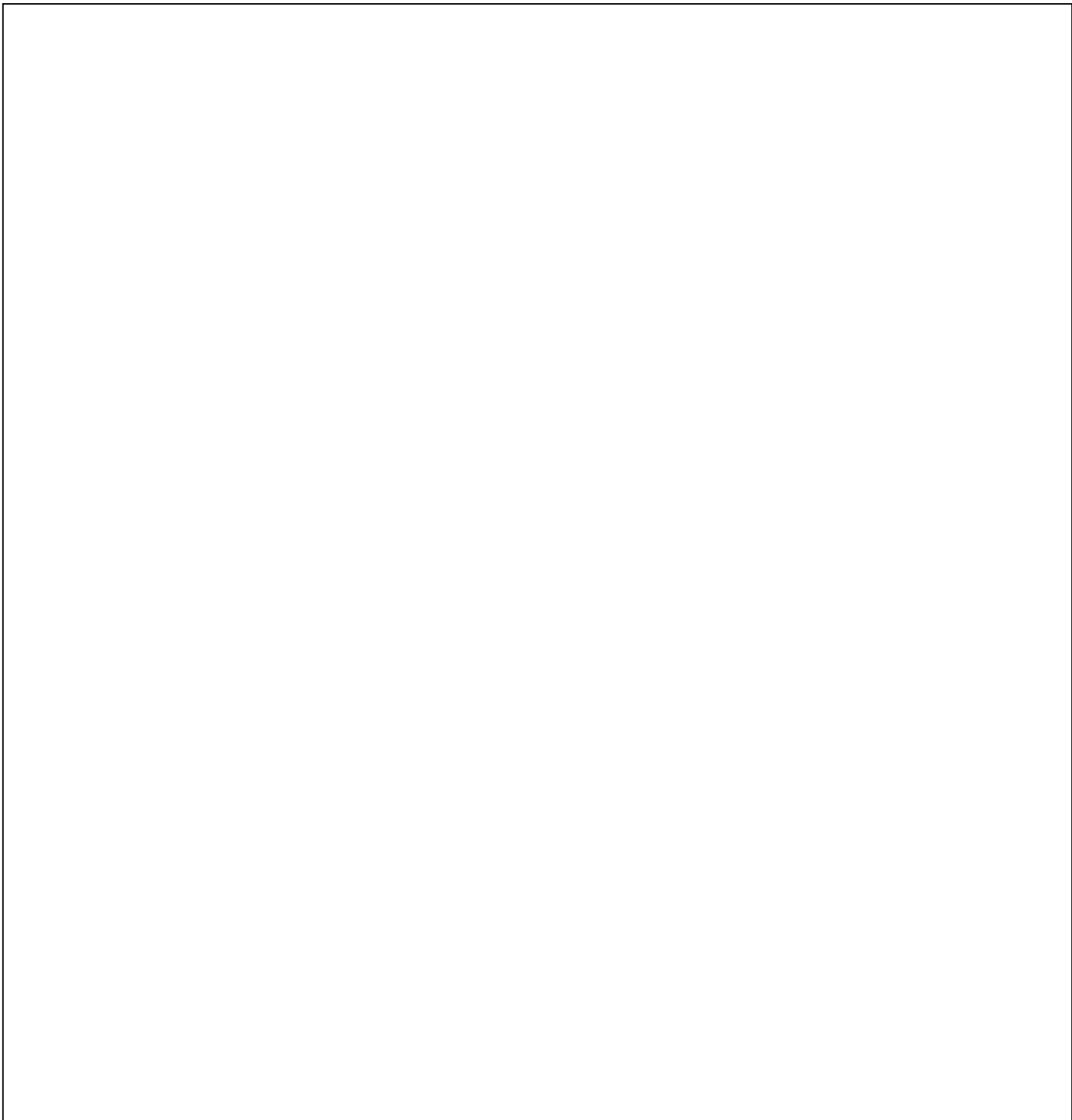




## Schools Praise Theo

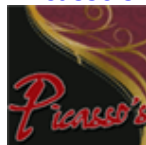
